# Summary of findings

## Overall summary

Five Rise Nursing Home is a care home providing personal and nursing care to older people and people living with dementia, a mental health condition and physical disability. The service accommodates up to 67 people across two separate floors, each of which has separate adapted facilities. At the time of the inspection 66 people were using the service.

We found the following examples of good practice.

The premises were clean and all areas were uncluttered so cleaning could take place effectively. Hand sanitisers and PPE stations were situated throughout the building. The service had effective processes in place so laundry was managed safely.

Staff were observed wearing appropriate PPE. There was prominent signage and instructions promoting infection prevention practices.

The service had robust infection control auditing systems.

### Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to the coronavirus pandemic we are looking at the preparedness of care homes in relation to infection prevention and control. This was a targeted inspection looking at the infection control and prevention measures the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 23 February 2021 and was announced.
