## Summary of findings

#### Overall summary

The Hawthornes Care Home is a residential care home providing personal and nursing care to 19 people aged 65 and over at the time of the inspection. The service can support up to 23 people. People were accommodated on two floors in a adapted Victorian building.

We found the following examples of good practice.

People who used the service were supported to maintain regular contact with friends and family.

Staff were mindful of the impact that isolating in their rooms might have on people. Staff supported people to engage in activities and interests whilst isolating.

Principles of zoning and grouping had been put into practice to help manage the outbreak.

#### Background to this inspection

We carried out this inspection under Section 60 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 as part of our regulatory functions. This inspection was planned to check whether the provider is meeting the legal requirements and regulations associated with the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

As part of CQC's response to care homes with outbreaks of coronavirus, we are conducting reviews to ensure that the Infection Prevention and Control practice was safe and the service was compliant with IPC measures. This was a targeted inspection looking at the IPC practices the provider has in place.

This inspection took place on 3 december 2020 and was unannounced.
